### Explanatory Notes

The results of GCSE examinations, including those for Short Courses, are reported on an eight-point grade scale: A\*(a\*), A(a), B(b), C(c), D(d), E(e), F(f) and G(g), of which Grade A\*(a\*) is the highest and Grade G(g) the lowest. Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard required for Grade G(g) are shown as Unclassified. Only subjects in which grades A\*(a\*) to G(g) are attained will be recorded on certificates.

The results of GCSE Double Award examinations are reported on a fifteen-point grade scale: A\*A\*(a\*a\*), A\*A(a\*a), AA(aa), AB(ab), BB(bb), BC(bc), CC(cc), CD(cd), DD(dd), DE(de), EE(ee), EF(ef), FF(ff), FG(fg) and GG(gg), of which Grade A\*A\*(a\*a\*) is the highest and Grade GG(gg) the lowest. Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard required for Grade GG(gg) are shown as Unclassified. Only subjects in which grades A\*A\*(a\*a\*) to GG(gg) are attained will be recorded on certificates.
